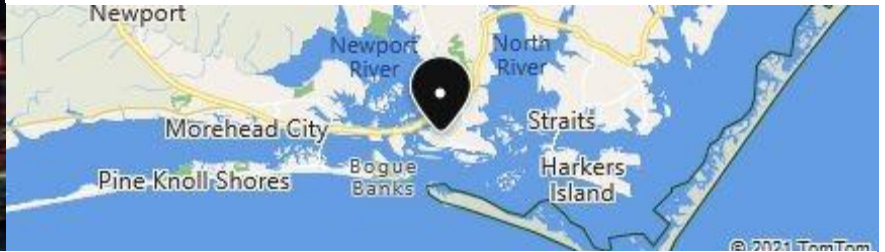




Nature's Spring Beauty At the Outer Banks of N.C.

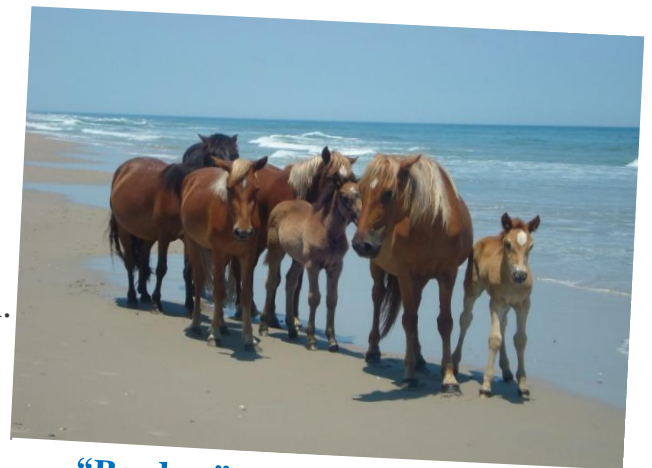
